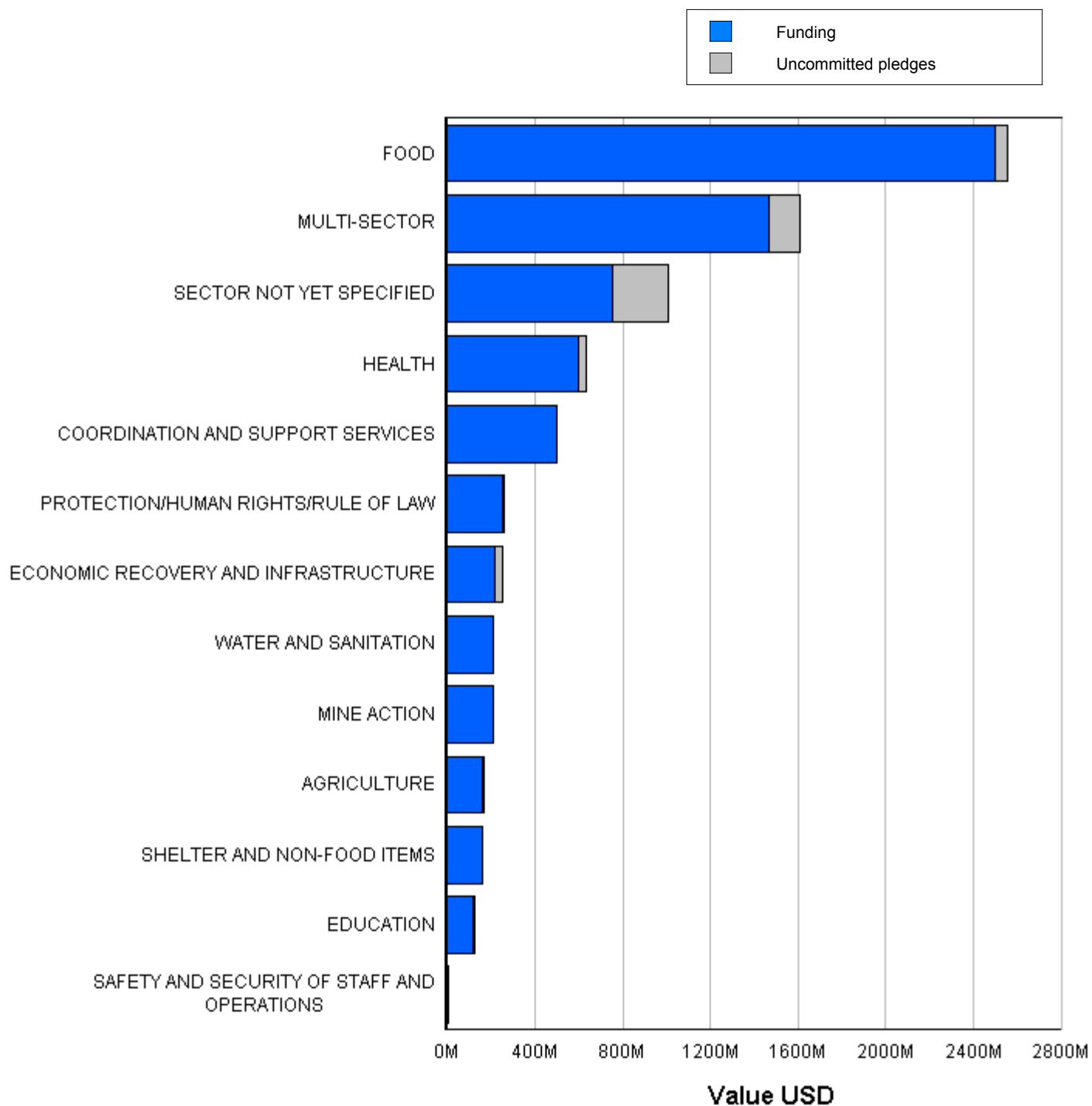
NOTE: "Funding" means Contributions + Commitments
